Symptoms and signs of G.E reflux


(General)

❖ Dystonic neck posturing (Sandifer syndrome)	❖ Poor WT gain








Red Flag For G.E REFLUX 2

▪ bilious vomiting	▪ hematemesis
▪ chronic diarrhea	▪ Rectal bleeding
▪ Persistent Forceful vomiting	▪ nocturnal vomiting
▪ abd. Distention

➤ Pyloric stenosis	➤ antral duodenal web
➤ malrotation with Volvulus	➤ F.B
➤ intussusception	➤ incarcerated hernia
➤ Hirschsprung	➤ Sup.mes.art. Syndrome




Differential Diagnosis OF G.E REFLUX (gastrointestinal)2

✓ galactosemia	✓ hereditary Fructose intolerance
✓ urea cycle defect	✓ amino and organic acidemia
✓ Fatty acid oxidation defect	✓ Met. acidosis
✓ Cong adrenal hyperplasia	✓ lead Poisoning
